Which Forex Broker Should You Use?

There are 2 brokers we highly recommend. Both are respectable brokers that work well with Automic Trader and are prompt with withdrawals and offer good support.

The first is Blaze Markets you can find them here: <u>https://www.blazemarkets.com</u>

Blaze Markets is a broker created by traders that got tired of dealing with poorly run brokerages. They wanted to create one that supports robot trading with optimal conditions. There are very fast execution speeds and competitive pricing.

Blaze Markets accepts most countries, but not United States based clients. For United States clients, please refer to the next broker recommendation.

The second broker is AdroFX you can find them here: <u>https://adrofx.com/?refid=7282D919-0101-</u> <u>4257-BB2D-3F4ED124F5A5</u> (select NA if from US when selecting country).

AdroFX is a solid broker with good trading conditions, prompt withdrawals, and overall good support. The systems work smoothly and has some solid offers. They accept United States Based clients when using our link above (must use our link - select NA for Country if not in the list).

After signing up with one of our recommended brokers download and install Meta Trader 4, which is provided free by them. (Please choose 100 – 200 leverage).

Account Type to Use

PRO accounts are preferred with lower spreads and good processing but works with STANDARD accounts and CENT / MICRO accounts. Minimum recommended deposit is \$1000 - \$2000. But you can start with as little as \$500 if you wish, which would be higher risk though, so not recommended. If you want to use a smaller account such as \$500, \$200, etc. Then use a CENT / Micro account. 6 Month Guarantee Requirements

In order to qualify for the 6-month guarantee, you will need to follow the EXACT setup rules.

- 1. You must use <u>https://www.blazemarkets.com/</u> broker. With 100 or 200 leverage.
- 2. The minimum deposit you use must be \$3,500.
- 3. You must use a VPS choose one from here https://www.leapfx.com/vps
- 4. You must use the best settings provided and not change them.
- 5. You must use safe risk settings found on next pages under Starting Lot recommendations.
- 6. Must avoid GBPJPY and EURGBP pair as these are higher risk and use only the other recommended pairs.
- 7. And finally, you must run it straight for 6 months.


Automic Trader Installation

1. Install Meta Trader 4 platform provided by your broker free and open it.

2. You will need to do the following configuration. At the top of MT4, Click Tools>Options>Expert Advisors. Check the same boxes as indicated below, then click Ok:

3. On the top of Meta Trader 4 make sure the AutoTrading is pushed in and GREEN, click it, if it's RED.



4. To install **Automic Trader** you will need to load the **AutomicTrader.ex4** file into the platform's data folder: At the top left of the platform click File>Open Data Folder>MQL4>Experts> and place the **.ex4** file there. Now restart the MT4 platform.

5. You should see Navigator window in your Meta Trader 4 platform on the middle left with **Automic Trader** in it (if you don't see it please click the + sign next to Expert Advisors):

Setting Up Automic Trader

6. Now we need to open the window within Meta Trader 4 for the currency pairs that the robot will be trading on. To do this click the **File** button at the top left, then click on **New Chart**, then you will look for the following currency pairs: **AUDUSD**, **EURGBP (Higher Risk Pair)**, **EURUSD**, **GBPJPY (Higher Risk Pair)**, **USDCAD**, **USDJPY** and click them to open OR right click on the PAIRS in Market Watch (a box with currency pairs on left side of the platform) and click Chart Window (if not you don't see some pairs, right click in the box and click SHOW ALL).

For each currency pair chart that you open - click on **"H1"** button towards the top of the screen to adjust the timeframe of that chart - do this before opening the next pair. This means each candlestick bar on the chart represents 1 hour.

7. Now click **Automic Trader** from the Navigator window (refer to step 5) and drag it onto each currency pair from step 6 or you can right click the **name** and choose "Attach to a chart" – it will attach to whichever chart you have in focus / open on the screen.

8. Once you attach **Automic Trader** to a chart window, a box will appear like the following below. Click **Common** then make sure the check marks match the following (then click **Inputs**):

9. Under inputs... enter your EMAIL ADDRESS and RECEIPT into the proper spaces, then...

You only need to adjust the **Starting Lot and Max Lot** setting, which is adjusting the lot size / risk for the system. The other settings can be left at default, unless you would like to experiment with changing settings or optimization.

Once you have adjusted settings or using default. You can click OK. And the software will begin running for you and you don't have to do anything from there.

Starting Lot and Max Lot Recommendations:

You can of course adjust or choose how you want to adjust the risk settings, but if you would like some guidance here is our recommendations.

LOW RISK

Starting Lot: .02 per \$3,500 - \$10,000 (can work with reasonable risk at \$1,000).

Max Lot (multiply by 3 each time): .06

MEDIUM RISK

Starting Lot: .05 for \$3,500 - \$10,000 (can work with \$1,000).

Max Lot (multiply by 3 each time): .15

HIGH RISK

Starting Lot: .1 per \$3,500 - \$8,000 (or .2 \$3,500 - \$8,000 for VERY HIGH RISK)

Max Lot (multiply by 3 each time): .3 or (.6 for very high risk)

Optional settings details:

Starting Lot: This is the lot size used to open initial trades.

Broker Digits: This is the number of digits for your broker pairs after the decimal. 99% of brokers are 5 digits so you should not touch this.

Magic Number: This is a unique number used by the robot to identify its own trades. No need to touch it.

Lot Multiplier: At certain times the lot size may increase this is the multiple of how much it will increase by.

Stop Loss: Automic Trader has a built-in dynamic stop loss for overall trades. So, it's not necessary to use this. But if you want to test using your own stop loss, feel free to use this. But note not recommended to adjust this.

Take Profit: This is the take profit target, but there is a trailing stop as well that accounts for open trades.

Profit Pips: This is a function of the trailing stop system as well.

Max Lot: This is the max lot size allowed to be opened at any time on a trade.

Repeat Same Lot: This is the number of times the software will use the same lot size on a pair's trade before it considers increasing lot size.

Once done changing any settings, click OK and the robot will start running. Note it won't trade instantly, but make sure NO errors in journal and expert tab. Repeat this for each pair running Automic Trader on.

If everything is loaded properly, there will be text stating: Automic Trader with a smiley emoticon on the top right of each currency pair chart you setup.

That is it. Configuration is finished! Let it run on its own 24/7. A VPS is HIGHLY Recommended - A VPS means it will run even if your computer is off and doesn't need to be installed on your computer.
