Installing Quick Scalp Trader...

STEP 1.


Double click the **SetupQST** application file that accompanied this manual within the ZIP file.

Follow the instructions within the installer, and choose the Meta Trader 4 platform you have installed that you want to install Quick Scalp Trader too.

Once complete, open Meta Trader 4.


STEP 2.

In Meta Trader 4, at the top, click Tools, then click Options, then click Expert Advisors. And make sure the checkmarks match the following picture...



STEP 3.

Make sure the AutoTrading / Automated Trading button on top is green, if not click it and it will then become green and pushed in.



Then, Click File, click New Chart, click EURUSD. Look at the top of the platform and click H1 at top. (**NOTE:** Put the software on this chart explained in next steps.)




After that, you will do this again, but for GBPUSD chart. Click File, click New Chart, click GBPUSD. Look at the top of the platform and click H1 at top. (**NOTE:** Put the software on this chart explained in next steps.)



STEP 4.


In the navigator box on the left middle, click the plus sign next to Expert Advisors and locate: Quick Scalp Trader. It doesn't matter what color it is. Click it and drag it over to the chart on the right (do this for the EURUSD chart and the GBPUSD chart).






STEP 5.

The following box will pop up, click COMMON on the top of it and make sure the checkmarks are set as shown. And then click **INPUTS**.



Under the INPUTS section you can optionally adjust a few settings for Quick Scalp Trader. You can leave these as default and it will run on your system properly, because auto risk management is set already. To better understand the settings and make changes, if you prefer, the next page explains each one.

After you are done making any adjustments, click OK, and the software will show information on the chart, and a smiley face on the top right, signifying that it is working properly. Now let it run on your PC or VPS 24/7 and it will automatically open, manage, and close trades for you.



Input Settings

<u>Order_lot</u>: If you prefer to use a set lot size instead of allowing money management to automatically choose your lot size based on a percentage of your account, then you can adjust this accordingly and set money_management to false.

<u>Money_management</u>: When this is set to false, the system will use the lot size you choose under order_lot to open trades. When set to true, the system will ignore order_lot and use risk_percent to automatically calculate lot sizes for you.

Risk percent: This is the max percentage of your account that you want to risk per trade. The system will determine lot sizes for you and will increase the lot sizes as the account grows. If you set 1, that means 10%, 2 means 20%, etc. We prefer 1. The system will attempt to come as close as possible to keep risk within the designated percentage.

Recovery_lot_multiplier: After certain losing trades, not often, the system will increase the lot size by a multiple of this amount. Default is recommended, but you are welcome to test and adjust it. If you use proper risk such as 1, the drawdown will usually remain low even with the multiplier.

<u>Max_Recovery_Levels</u>: The max number of times in a row that the multiplier will occur. Then it will go back to the previous lot size and continue as normal.

<u>Magic_number</u>: This number is a unique identifier for each trade opened by Quick Scalp Trader. It allows the system to identify and manage its own trades. If you have other trades open, it will not interfere with those trades, only trades with this magic number.

<u>Text_corner</u>: Select where you want the software dashboard to appear on the trading chart, which provides some information about the system, your account, and trading status.

Need help deciding risk or lot size to use?

By default, the system is set to 1 risk, which is essentially 10% risk. This is a reasonable risk for most people to use. And doesn't need to be adjusted.

If you prefer to be more cautious and select fixed lots, because of a smaller account, or you want more control, then start with a low fixed lot and increase it as you see fit.

Alternatively, if you are a risk seeker, you may want to increase that risk % and go for larger wins, but please keep in mind the drawdown can be much higher with every increase of the risk.
